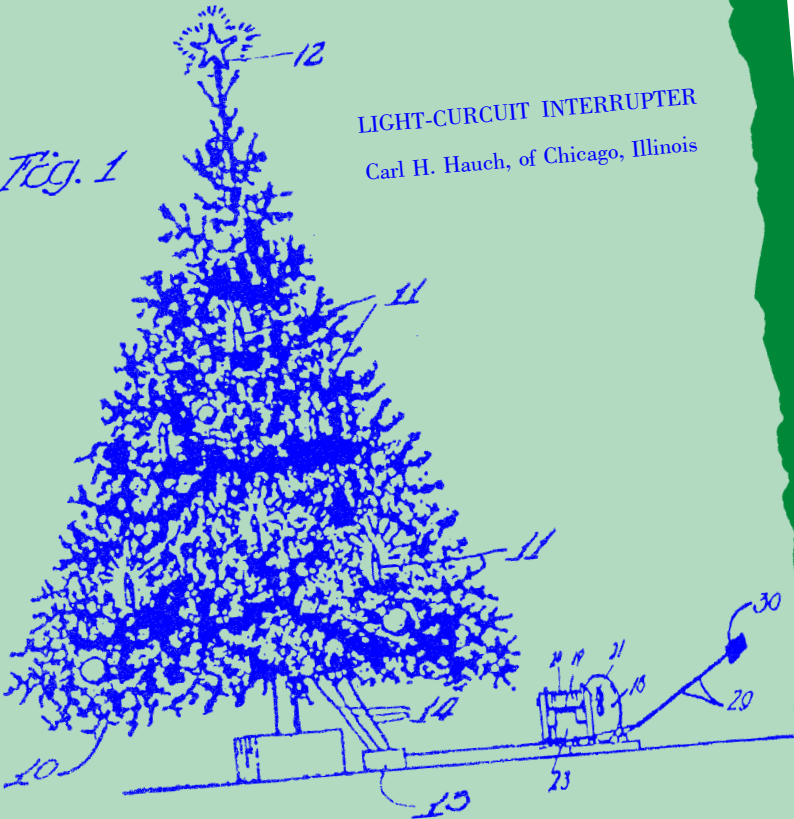

LIGHT-CURCUIT INTERRUPTER

In many kinds of decorative lighting and especially in lighting for Christmas Trees, the artistic effect can be very greatly increased by imparting a twinkling or flickering in the incandescent lights. My claim is for a decorative electric lighting system havinig incandescent lights, combined with a means for interrupting the current supply to produce a wavering in the light similar to that of the simulated source.
